# "...Indeed, the 'right time' is now..." 2 Corinthians 6:2 NLT

The Scripture above has been read by me hundreds, if not thousands, of times in my Christian experience. As I read once again these verses, these words 'jumped out' at me:

"...indeed, the 'right time' is now. Today is the day of salvation."

2018 has arrived. It is the New Year ... the time for new year's resolutions, commitments, changes, and arrangement of priorities. It is a time to turn over a 'new leaf,' get a fresh start, and engage in habits and practices that are beneficial to you and others!

In concert with this, the following paragraph in the book, America at the Crossroads, by George Barna struck deep into my soul:

"... Americans are not ideological purists. One significant reason for the ideological confusion and inconsistency that prevail in America today-apart from the labels people embrace-is: we no longer possess an anchor for truth. In contemporary America, truth is whatever we say it is. We have adopted the mindset that everyone must determine their own truth, and nobody can legitimately question the veracity of the perspective for that individual."

What is happening to us? Even as I write I received notice that a Christian church in England was celebrating Muhammad's birthday and the birthday of Jesus together in December. What is happening?

Indeed, the 'right time is now' to do what needs to be done and to be all God wants us to be. Listen and factor in the last two months of activities within our nation (not to mention the world). It is now time to be, to do, and to stand in relationship to what God wants! I am totally convinced that what believers would like to do for Him or give to Him in a ministry of their choosing, or be in obedience to His Word, the 'right time is NOW!' Later will be too late!

There is a rising hostility toward Christians, a secularization of society that is growing exponentially and extremely off balance in beliefs, distorting their behavior, and a deepening of 'foolishness' in processing facts and making decisions and judgments. We are losing our way. Some may even say, we have lost our way! The 'anchor of truth' is gone. It is the book of Ecclesiastes in full motion!

#### "When I considered all that I had accomplished and what I had labored to achieve, I found everything to be futile and a pursuit of the wind. There was nothing to be gained under the sun." Ecclesiastes 2:11 HCSB

But there is Good News! The Word of God gives Truth. God's truth shapes beliefs. Beliefs are foundational for Values. Values give birth to Godly Character. And Character is the platform of behavior. Truth is not subjective; it is objective, presented by the Almighty! Making it even simpler, clearer, and concise, Paul tells the believers in Ephesus: "... the truth is in Jesus." Ephesians 4:21 NKJV

Jesus is our 'gold standard.' There is none other! In fact, I am confident that you believers who are reading this immediately think of John14:6 NKJV, a statement from Jesus:

"... I am the way, the truth, and the life, no one comes to the Father except through Me."
