  - 1. *Life Change* Scholarships for students who cannot financially afford to attend. Upon completing their FASFA, a scholarship could be awarded after a student has utilized government funding and other gifts but continue to have financial need
  - 2. *Strengthening* our faculty & staff. Other faculty members are very qualified in their areas of expertise and we want to express our appreciation to them. Assisting our staff is another area to express thankfulness to them for their service to Him.
  - 3. Enhancing the ambiance of the College for student encouragement and learning. Landscaping, outdoor seating, and much more has been completed and are in the plans.

To date over \$230,000 has been given. Additional year-end gifts are anticipated. This is an excellent opportunity to bless His students with His provisions through your resourcing.
