Something New for Something Refreshing Part 2

If you remember last month's devotional, we were stressing that when God does something **NEW** for His people, it brings refreshing! Isaiah 40-66 demonstrates that when God performs something new - *new things, new secrets - and speaks new words* (Isaiah 48:6-8 NLT), He <u>challenges</u> you, <u>changes</u> you, and then He <u>commissions</u> you! You are on a 'New Path' of Promise! You cannot remain 'idle.' You are changed to challenge others with the 'Good News!' There is a 'calling' to this. It is a 'commission.' It is authority granted to proclaim and to act.

Sense this calling in your life:

"<u>The Lord will guide you</u> continually, giving you water when you are dry and restoring your strength. You will be like a well-watered garden, like an ever-flowing spring. Some of you will rebuild the deserted ruins of your cities. Then you will be known as a rebuilder of walls and a restorer of homes." Isaiah 58:11-12 NLT

Herein is the Refreshing: God will guide you! He will be your pilot! He will be your leader! He will go first! He will give 'water' to restore your strength. Then you will have the Divine appointment as a **Rebuilder and Restorer!** What a high and noble calling!

A **Rebuilder** of protection, security, and safety (walls) is *so needed today*. A **Restorer** of relationships, fellowship, and intimacy (home) is *so needed today*. What a high calling! What an awesome responsibility and position!

1. A Peacefulness/Restfulness

That step will result in peace ... real, tangible peace that generates restfulness. There is too much 'pulling of hair' today, wringing of hands, and muttering of regrets.

2. Freshness/Newness

God's 'water' and enablement brings 'freshness.' There is nothing quite like fresh bread, fresh salad, fresh baked goods, fresh fish and fresh meat! Working with and for God is exhilarating and exciting. *The same is always new!*

3. Richness

There will be a sense of 'wealth, understanding, wisdom, and gain' in doing His Will. It will be experienced richly. It is simply enrichment of body soul and spirit. It is gain for you and gain for Him.

4. Joyfulness

The Scripture is very clear: Ps 21:6 refers to 'exceeding gladness' and Ps 16:11 refers to 'fullness of Joy' ... *in His Presence, doing His Will!* More joy is needed in believers today!
