# Something New for Something Refreshing Part 1

Isaiah 40-66 is simply amazing, breathtaking, and very stimulating! This portion of Scripture is as packed with personal application for the child of God now as it was when it was first penned.

In his book, Strength for the Weary, Dr. Derk Thomas recorded the following:

"The rabbis called Isaiah 40-66 'the Book of Consolation' ... From the doom of Isaiah's warning of Babylonian exile to the glorious words of triumphant release, without so much as a pause for breath! Glorious! God, the end and the beginning. And when we find ourselves in the fog of despair He knows the way out; He knows how this story will end because He has planned it and controls it."

God breathes Comfort to His people. No, they did not listen. They were stubborn in action, and unfocused in purpose. In one passage, Isaiah states:

"...Your necks are as unbending as iron. Your heads are as hard as bronze." Isaiah 48:4 NLT

Sound like someone you know? But He wants His people who are in this state to know comfort, joy, peace, and hope for the future. Dr. Thomas makes this statement to remember:

"Our comfort, or well-being in the deepest and grandest of senses, lies as a burden upon His heart." To that I say ... Wow!

In reading through this portion of Scripture, I recorded the following verses for you:

"For I am about to do something new. See, I have already begun! Do you not see it? I will make a pathway through the wilderness. I will create rivers in the dry wasteland ... Yes, I will make rivers in the dry wasteland, so my chosen people can be refreshed." Isaiah 43:19-20 NLT

"...Now I will tell you new things, secrets you have not yet heard. They are brand new, not things from the past. So you cannot say, 'We knew that all the time!' Yes, I will tell you of things that are entirely new, things you never heard of before..." Isaiah 48:6-8 NLT

**Something New for Something Refreshing!** Pause, Ponder, Reflect, and Allow God's words to penetrate your very soul. He says this to them in their bewildered and rebellious state. They are struggling, hurting, and wandering. But as He spoke to them, He is speaking to you right this moment in your 'wasteland' of life challenges, hurts, disappointments, and longings.

"I am doing something new for you ... do you not see it? Look around and see! Do you hear what I am saving? It is special for you!"

#### What happens to you when you receive something new?

We had a new couch delivered to the house ... it is new, smells new, looks new, feels new, it <u>is</u> NEW! It affects us in so many ways. However, there is no comparison when the Divine gives something new ... and it appears in many forms and sensed in many ways.

I will unpack this next month ... be watching, listening, and thinking in your life ... keep notes, dear reader ... your 'rivers of refreshing are coming!' The smell is in the air!




