- All classes for both Traditional and Degree Completion (Quest) programs are being held online so that students can finish this semester successfully.
- Faculty and Staff are working from home. Operations of the College are being conducted daily with critical-mission staff on campus, following the CDC and U. S. Department of Education guidelines. Admissions personnel are working tirelessly from their homes, preparing for the Fall semester.
- Video-Audio Conferencing with ABHE, government, U. S. Department of Education, and other resources has been helpful and ongoing. Meetings with faculty and staff are held via Google Go Meet.
- The College is exploring "relief funding" through the Cares Act that includes support for students and operational needs.

- The **2020 Annual Banquet and 2020 Commencement** are under review.
- The L.L. Speer Hall has been transitioned to nine students who have extenuating circumstances. A Safety Team is on campus.
- All community events meetings, services, and gatherings (including Frisbee Golf) have been postponed. Church services on campus have been cancelled and the Genesis School has moved to online delivery of content.
